Direct Benefits of Sponsorship

- A de-identified list of companies and job titles who registered for the event

Costs of Sponsorship

Sponsorship costs vary from venue to venue, but typically in 2024 the minimum we recommend spending is \$500.00-\$600.00 for appetizers. We do not require sponsors to spend money on drinks, but they are welcome to. Certain venues do require spending money on drinks (Westgate Wine), which does result in a more expensive event. We try to avoid venues that require a fee for the space, unless it is refunded through the amount spent by the sponsor and attendees.

What We Do for an Event

- We work to find venues and once we establish your budget, we can make recommendations about food, drinks, past attendence, and potential hiccups.
- We set up the event using Eventbrite for registrations
- We make Linked In announcements
- We send our email campaign using our list of past registrants
- We also can try to tailor events if there is a specific audience you are tying to reach

What We Need from You

Should you decide you want to sponsor an event, we need a couple of things to help promote the event. 1) We need a company logo that we will use in the Eventbrite page, email campaign, and Linked In posts. 2) We need a short description of your company for the previous reasons. 3) When it is time to pay for the sponsor portion, we need to be able to put you in contact with the venue. NCBPNG is a not-for-profit group, meaning we cannot accept money even if it would be spent on group events, so we need to be able to put you in direct contact with the venue/vendor.
